A weekly bin service has been started so all the village bins are now emptied by Stratford District Council, at a cost of £500 per year. Dog owners can now deposit dog faeces in any of the village bins provided.

The amenity cleaning and grass cutting salary will be reduced from 1st April 2016 from £220.00 per month to £200.00 per month.
