School Lane footpath after the stile is slippery to walk on. Councilor Bob Stevens recommended we contact the County Council who might have some suggestions about what can be done.

4. Local Police Issues

PCO Katrina Taylor attended the meeting and provided updates effecting Priors Marston.

Rural Crimes - a trailer has been reported stolen in Priors Marston so the police have increased patrols in the local area

School Parking – during peak times parking is naturally busy at the school, PCO Taylor is conducting patrols at the school to ensure local residents access is not affected at these key times.

a. Highway Issues

Holloway Flooding

Logged our concerns at the Warwickshire Flood Workshop and will wait further advice in the meantime we have an emergency kit which will be allocated in the telephone box once the defibrillator is installed.

School Road Kerbing

WCC suggested the best solution would be concrete kerbing that can be driven over, and repairs where required to the road, agreed to go ahead, this is with Highways and awaiting a timescale

Signs/SLOW

In hand with Richard Elbourne from WCC Traffic, this should be completed before Christmas

Speeding

Speed data gathered from Transport & Highways have highlighted areas of concern so have contacted Southam Police force to co-ordinate speed checks and enforcement.

Bus Shelter Fruit Trees

Overgrown trees have been examined by WCC Highways and advised they do not belong to WCC therefore the responsibility of the parish council, will contact tree surgeon for advice on pruning possible removal

Horse Chestnut Tree School Lane

Have asked WCC highways Forestry to check this tree and advise on its health

The Orchard

Land adjacent to The Orchard previously indicated as village green is dedicated highway, this has been communicated to Southam Police.

b. Defibrillator

Awaiting the outcome of the telephone box consultation with BT & Stratford District Council, will update early 2015

c. Winter Preparation

Analysis of the village grit bins shows that 5 bins service the village; we are putting a proposal to WCC highways for an additional bin.
